David Lemewu is a Catholic priest from the Missionaries of God's Love (MGL) and a covenant member of the Disciples of Jesus Community (DOJ). David was born in Indonesia in 1974 and completed high school there until he came to Australia in 1993 where he then graduated from the Bachelor of Aerospace Engineering (1988) and the Masters in Systems Engineering (2000) from RMIT (Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology) University.

David was a regular cantor and musician at St Augustine and St Francis Church in Melbourne (1999-2004). He undertook the leading role in the musical Call of Guadalupe (2005-8), Saul Saul Paul Paul (2008-9), and Amazing Augustine (2015 in which he co-wrote the songs). David has recorded two CDs of his own composition in 2010 (Everlasting) & 2016 (Alive).

David graduated from the Bachelor of Theology (2013) and Masters in Theological Studies (2015) from the University of MCD (Melbourne College of Divinity). He joined the MGL in 2009 and was ordained a priest in August 2016. He is currently the director of St Benedict Mission Centre in Canberra. He has ministered people in the jail and detention centres in Canberra, Melbourne, Jakarta, Darwin and Bali.
