
21st to 27th

Letter from Peter



Dear Friend,

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith.

I understand fixing my eyes upon something or someone to mean that I give it/them my full focus. If you like, I become consumed with what I'm looking at. As I continue my gaze, the object – in this case the person of Jesus – becomes more important to me than anything else. He appears to me everywhere; I see Him in everything.

This appears to me as a logical sequence of my taking up His invitation to "Come, follow me." I look to him for direction. I study his ways that I might endeavour to emulate them. But, perhaps more than anything else, as I keep my eyes fixed in him, avidly taking in all He has for me, I am drawn deeper into the intimate relationship that He offers me. I am, at once, held, affirmed, healed, comforted, equipped, strengthened and loved. Truly, I know that I am special to Him.

May you experience this as you reach out to him in prayer. May you choose to fix your eyes on Him. May you know just how special you are.
