- 14 Pray for Torch ministry as it works towards extending its programmes into more Juvenile Justice Centres.

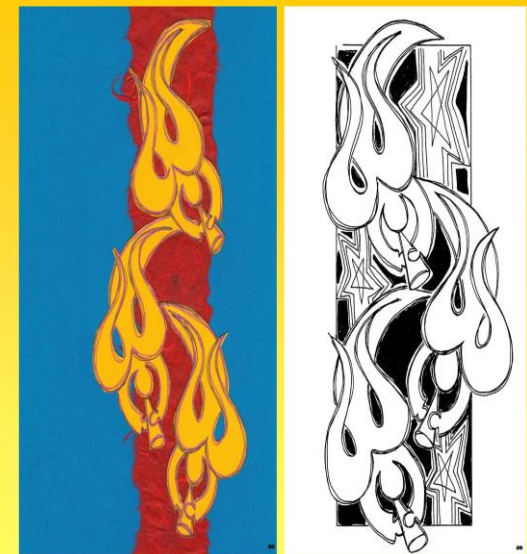
